

Correcting Your I-94 Admission Number

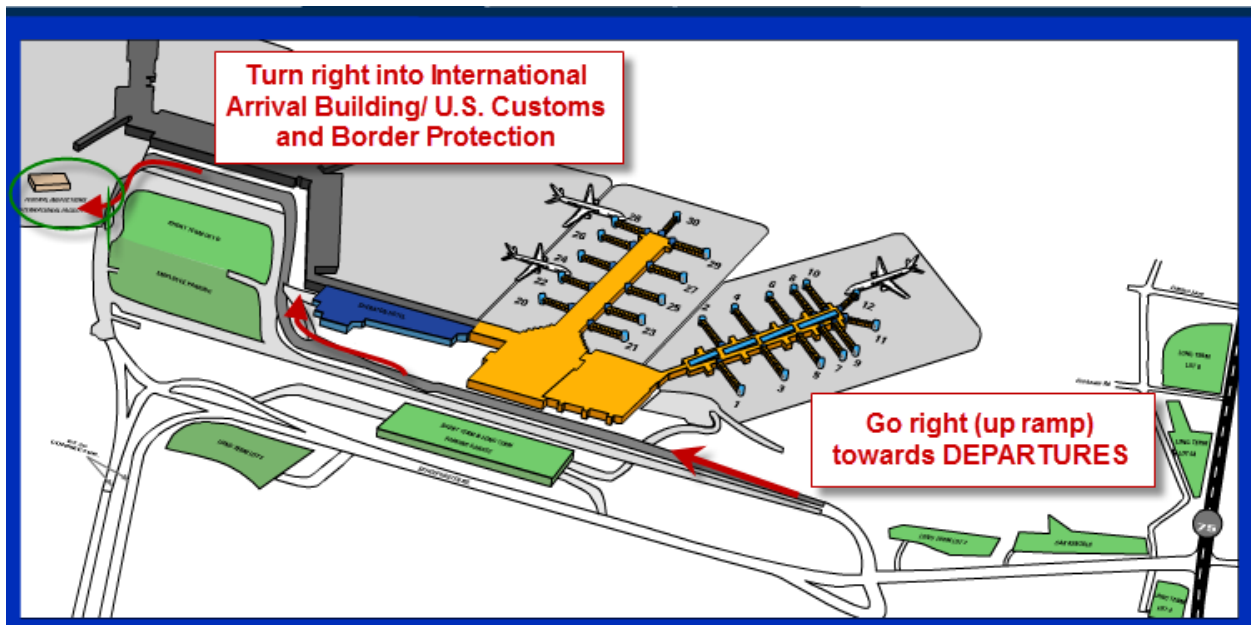
If your Admission (I-94) Number was “**Not Found**” when you tried to retrieve it online then you will need to have your number corrected at the nearest Customs and Border Protection (CBP) Deferred Inspections port. Depending on your UConn campus or where you live, this could be Bradley International Airport– Hartford, Logan International Airport – Boston, or JFK International Airport – New York. Some CBP Deferred Inspection sites require you to make an appointment, but others do not. When you call for an appointment or go to the office (if appointment is not necessary), explain that you are an F-1/J-1 student or J-1 visiting scholar at the University of Connecticut and your I-94 Admission number is “Not Found” on the CBP website. You will need to have your passport, F-1/J-1 visa, and I-20/DS-2019 form ready when you call in case the officer needs information from these documents. On the day of your appointment be sure to bring all these documents to the airport with you.

Bradley International Airport – Appointment Required – Call (860)-627-8767

You must schedule an appointment with Customs and Border Protection at Bradley Airport in order to have your I-94 corrected.

Bus to Bradley

From Hartford (Union Station or Connecticut Convention Center): Take the **30 – Bradley Flyer** to the Airport. Ask the driver to let you off at the International Arrivals Building and ask the driver where to stand to get picked up for your return trip. To get a Map and Schedule see:

Bus to Bradley cont'd

From Storrs: **Megabus**– take the mega bus to Hartford. The bus unloads on Columbus Blvd, continue on Columbus Blvd to the Connecticut Convention Center where you can pick up the **30 – Bradley Flyer**.

From Storrs: **Peter Pan** – take the Peter Pan bus to Hartford. The bus unloads at Union Station; walk through the parking lot to Spruce St. to pick up the **30 – Bradley Flyer**. Alternatively, you can also get a taxi from Union Station to the airport as well.

Bus to Logan International Airport

While you can take the Peter Pan bus directly from UConn to Logan International Airport, it leaves campus too late for you to arrive by 4:00 p.m. You will need to drive to Logan, take a morning bus from Hartford or take another form of public transport to arrive during 8:00– 4:00 business hours.

Bus to JFK International Airport

While you can take the bus from UConn to New York City it leaves campus too late for you to arrive by 2:00 p.m. You will need to drive to JFK, take a morning bus from Hartford or take another form of public transport to arrive during 8:00– 2:00 business hours.
