## Finding/Correcting Your I-94 Admission Number

Sometimes international students and exchange visitors have problems related to their I-94 Admission Number. Some common problems include:

- Your I-94 Admission Number is “**Not Found**”
- Your I-94 Admission Number shows that you were admitted incorrectly to the U.S. – see an ISSS advisor
- Your I-94 Admission Number shows that you are admitted until a specific date (not D/S) – see an ISSS advisor.

### I-94 “Not Found”

If your I-94 cannot be found, this probably means that your information was incorrectly entered into your record, and requires correction by U.S. Customs and Border Protection. Most UConn students must contact the Deferred Inspection Site at Bradley International Airport in Windsor Locks, CT.

Step 1: Call and explain that you are an F-1 or J-1 student or scholar, that your I-94 cannot be found, and it needs correcting.

Step 2: If the issue cannot be resolved by phone, they will arrange an appointment with you to visit the Deferred Inspection Site to correct your record. Please see contact information and transportation instructions below.

**Stamford campus** students may call Bradley Airport and follow the above steps, or may try to seek assistance in-person from the New York City Deferred Inspection Site at JFK International Airport (no appointment needed). We cannot guarantee that JFK will be willing to correct I-94 records for Stamford students, though they have been helpful in the past.

### I-94 Found, but Incorrect

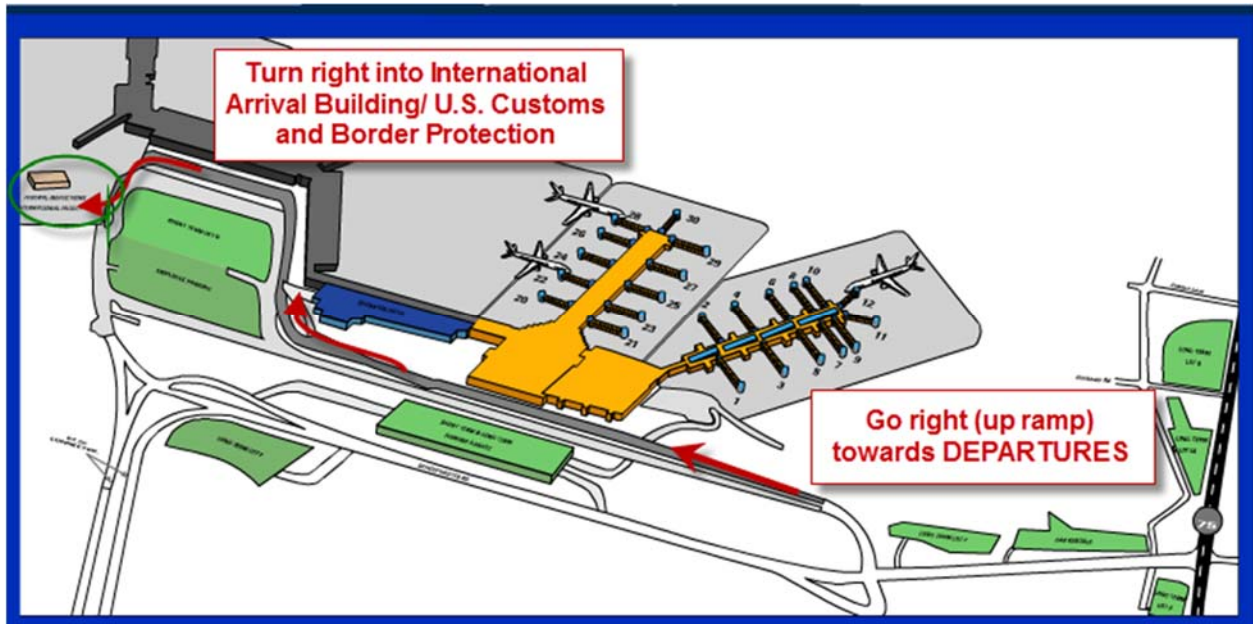
If your I-94 shows that you were admitted in a different visa status than your intended visa, or if it shows that you are admitted until a specific date (not D/S), this must be corrected **as soon as possible**. You must meet with an ISSS advisor to discuss your travel experience and determine how to best correct your record. Make an appointment with your international advisor for further details.

From Storrs: Take CT Transit bus 913 from Storrs Center to Hartford Union Station. Visit [www.cttransit.com](http://www.cttransit.com) for the 913 bus schedule. From Hartford, follow directions below.

From Hartford: From the Hartford **Union Station** stop, take bus **30 – Bradley Flyer** to the Airport. Ask the driver to let you off at the International Arrivals Building and ask the driver where to stand to get picked up for your return trip.
